

Enrollment Requirements

Applicants who are admitted to the LLM are required to submit to the following items in order to finalize their enrollment at Michigan State University College of Law. The College of Law is unable to waive these requirements or alter the deadlines for receipt of these materials:

- An enrollment deposit of \$300 (U.S.) within three weeks of acceptance to the College of Law. This nonrefundable deposit will be applied toward the first semester of tuition. This fee may be paid by credit card. Refer to the Enrollment Form for details.
- An official transcript issued by the institution that granted the law degree. If the transcript is not in English, an equivalency must be submitted through WES, ECE or LSAC by July 1.
- Evidence of sufficient financial resources to cover the costs of the LLM program. For the 2009/10 academic year, total costs (tuition, fees, supplies, housing, food, transportation, etc.) are expected to be \$_____. Refer to the Enrollment Form for details.
- Proof of medical insurance, including the name of the insurance company and policy number.
- For non-native English speakers, official documentation showing a TOEFL score at or above 100 for the internet-based test. This requirement may be waived for individuals who have resided in an English-speaking country for more than two years and who complete an interview with a College of Law representative.
- Visa documentation sent by the Law College must be completed by all dates listed on the documents.
- Full payment of all tuition and fees no later than one month prior to matriculation.
