Application for Admission LL.M. for Foreign-Educated Lawyers

The one-year Master of Laws (LL.M.) Program for Foreign-Educated Lawyers provides a rigorous academic program to advance the legal training of those who are qualified to practice law outside of the U.S. The Program enrolls students starting in both the Winter (January) and Fall (August) term. **The application deadline for January enrollment is November 1, and for August enrollment is the deadline is April 1.** Late applications will be accepted on a limited basis. **No application fee is required.**

Statement of Interest, Letters of Reference, English Language Proficiency Scores, and Transcripts

Please submit with this application:

1. A brief statement that describes your interest in Michigan State University College of Law's LLM for Foreign-Educated Lawyers. This statement may be one or two pages in length, and should be a sample of your professional writing sufficient to show your comprehension of and writing skills in English.
2. Two or more letters of recommendation are **strongly recommended**, though not required.
3. Transcripts from all degrees earned. Unofficial transcripts may be sent with your application, but official transcripts must be received prior to enrollment. If the transcripts are not in English, the transcripts must be translated and certified/notarized. **Transcript information will be verified for the College of Law by an independent transcript evaluation service.**
4. The scores from an English language proficiency test, such as the TOEFL, Pearson Test, or IELTS. Unofficial test results may be sent, but official scores must be received prior to enrollment.

Merit- and Need-Based Financial Aid

All candidates will be considered for merit awards. Candidates will be supplied, after admission, with a need-based financial aid application upon request of the applicant.
